

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 314844

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 23 2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS ACCESS, INC.; BAYSIDE COMMUNITY CENTER; ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION-SAN DIEGO COUNTY DBA SAN DIEGO REGIONAL EDC; AND RIDER SAFETY VISIBILITY, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) received and evaluated four applications for Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

Access, Inc.	Linda Vista Community Outdoors	Beautifies the neighborhood.
Bayside Community Center	Community Room and Office Improvements	Provides community residents a clean and efficient meeting space.
Economic Development Corporation-San Diego County dba San Diego Regional EDC	Regional Talent Development Through Advancing San Diego	Assists students and employers advance economically.

Rider Safety Visibility	Pedal Ahead	Promotes active living and healthy lifestyles amongst San Diego communities.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 7 recommends an allocation of \$4,500 to Access, Inc. for benches, picnic tables, grills, trash cans, landscaping, ground coverings, and equipment to secure furniture from theft, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 7 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Bayside Community Center for furniture, electronic equipment, office, equipment, and program supplies, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 7 recommends an allocation of \$1,500 to the Economic Development Corporation–San Diego County dba San Diego Regional EDC for personnel costs and web tools, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 7 recommends an allocation of \$4,000 to Rider Safety Visibility for outreach and marketing materials, computer upgrades, and riding equipment, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for the Economic Development Corporation–San Diego County dba San Diego Regional EDC, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) Access, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$4,500, (2) Bayside Community Center in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (3) the Economic Development Corporation–San Diego County dba San Diego Regional EDC in an amount not to exceed \$1,500, and (4) Rider Safety Visibility in an amount not to exceed \$4,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314844-1 for Access, Inc., Document No. RR- 314844-2 for Bayside Community Center, Document No. RR- 314844-3 for the Economic Development Corporation–San Diego County dba San Diego Regional EDC, and Document No. RR- 314844-4 for Rider Safety Visibility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,000 from Council District 7: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1107110007, all to

provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
