A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING THE POTENTIAL ACCEPTANCE OF DONATIONS OF REAL PROPERTY FROM MISSION TRAILS REGIONAL PARK FOUNDATION, TO BE INCORPORATED INTO MISSION TRAILS REGIONAL PARK IN THE EAST ELLIOTT AREA OF SAN DIEGO, SUBJECT TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S ANALYSIS AND DUE DILIGENCE.

WHEREAS, the Mission Trails Regional Park Foundation (Foundation) was formed in 1988 as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization to preserve, improve, develop, and maintain Mission Trails Regional Park (MTRP) and to foster public appreciation and understanding of MTRP; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation partners with the City of San Diego (City) to preserve and protect the natural environment of MTRP and provide and promote educational and recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation obtained a \$2 million grant from the San Diego River

Conservancy (Conservancy) to acquire and concurrently donate real property in the East Elliott

area of San Diego (Property) to the City at no cost for incorporation into MTRP; and

WHEREAS, the Property would be acquired for the purposes of watershed protection, preservation of habitat and open space, protection of sensitive species, protection of wildlife corridors, trail access, and implementation of the Multiple Species Conservation Program and the 2019 Mission Trail Regional Park Master Plan Update in accordance with the Conservancy's grant; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has requested the City's support for the Foundation's efforts to acquire and donate the Property to the City; and

WHEREAS, should the City's support be obtained, the Foundation intends to proceed with acquiring the Property; and

WHEREAS, prior to City's acceptance of a Property donation, City staff would perform due diligence and then present each proposed Property donation to the Council of the City of San Diego for authorization to accept each donation consistent with Council Policy 100-02 Donation Acceptance; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Council supports the potential real property donations, subject to the City's completion of analysis and due diligence in accordance with Council Policy 100-02, from the Mission Trails Regional Park Foundation for watershed protection, preservation of habitat and open space, protection of sensitive species, protection of wildlife corridors, trail access, and implementation of the

Multiple Species Conservation Program and the 2019 Mission Trails Regional Park Master Plan
