A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FUNDS, AND ALL RELATED ACTIONS, FOR SAN YSIDRO COMMUNITY ACTIVITY CENTER ENHANCEMENTS AND BEYER COMMUNITY PARK PHASE II CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 contains \$2,982,285,641 in

Economic Development Initiative funding for the purpose of providing Community Project

Funding/Congressionally-directed grants (Grant Program); and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2023 Community Project Funding (CPF) grants will be

administered by the Congressional Grants Division of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban

Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the procedures established requires the applicant's Governing Body to

certify by resolution the approval of the grant application before submission of the application; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to receive \$4,000,000 for San Ysidro Community Activity

Center Enhancements and \$3,000,000 for Beyer Community Park Phase II Construction in Fiscal

Year 2023 (Projects); and

WHEREAS, successful applicants will enter into a contract with the United States of America to complete the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to make an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Program (Grant Program) for an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 for San Ysidro Community Activity Center Enhancements and \$3,000,000 for Beyer Community Park Phase II Construction in Fiscal Year 2023 (Projects).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that the City understands the assurances and certification in the Project Application Package.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies the City has or will have available, prior to commencement of Project work utilizing specified grant funds, sufficient funds, including those provided by this grant, to complete the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies the City has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the Project Application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to conduct all negotiations, sign, and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, the Project Application Form, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the grant's scope of work.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), HUD's NEPA-implementing regulations at 24 CFR Part 50 or 24 CFR Part 58, and all appropriate federal environmental and historic preservation laws, regulations, and Executive Orders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure funding from HUD for the completion of the Project.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital improvements Program Budget (CIP) in CIP AGF00007, Park Improvements, (B20097 San Ysidro Community Activity Center Enhancements).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 in Grant Program funding from Fund 600000 Grant Fund – Federal for the San Ysidro Community Activity Center Enhancements Project, if the grant funding is secured, contingent upon the receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the CIP Budget in CIP S23008, Beyer Community Park Phase II Construction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 in Grant Program funding from Fund 600000 Grant Fund – Federal for the Beyer Community Park Phase II Construction Project, if the grant funding is secured, contingent upon the receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer appropriations of \$600,000 from CIP B19176, Sunset Point Comfort Station Improvements, to CIP B18079, Mission Bay Projects Environmental Impact Report within Fund 200386, Mission Bay Park Improvement Fund. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any grant funding discussed above is secured, the

Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for such

grant, if required.
