A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE LA MEDIA IMPROVEMENT SIEMPRE VIVA TO TRUCK ROUTE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the La Media Improvement Siempre Viva to Truck Route Capital

Improvements Program (CIP) project (Project) will reconstruct La Media Road to improve safety

and roadway conditions for truck traffic traveling to the Otay Mesa Port of Entry; and

WHEREAS, Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending

(CPF/CDS) is a type of federal funding that is appropriated and allocated for Transit

Infrastructure Grants on an annual basis and at the discretion of Congress; and

WHEREAS, the Project was identified to receive up to \$400,000 in CPF/CDS funds in

the Consolidated Appropriations Act, H.R. 2471, 117th Cong. (2022); and

WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 2022 CPF/CDS grants are funded at 100 percent federal share,

as Congress did not specify a local match requirement; and

WHEREAS, CPF/CDS funding will support preliminary engineering, design, and right-

of-way review for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to take all necessary actions to apply to the U.S. Department of Transportation to secure grant

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funding for an amount not to exceed \$400,000 in CPF/CDS funding for CIP S-22006, La Media Improv-Siempre Viva to Truck Rte (B-19020, La Media Improv-Siempre Viva to Truck Rte), to support preliminary engineering, design, and right-of-way review.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$400,000 if the grant funding is secured.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interestbearing account for the grant, if required.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP S-22006, La Media Improv-Siempre Viva to Truck Rte (B-19020, La Media Imprv-Siempre Viva to Truck Rte), and to appropriate and expend an amount equal to the amount of CPF/CDS grant funding actually received, but not to exceed \$400,000, for the purpose of preliminary engineering, design, and right-of-way review, contingent upon the receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
