## DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 2 6 2023

## A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE ADDITION OF MIRAMAR WATER TREATMENT PLANT RESIDUALS REDIRECTION TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM AND RELATED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, Pure Water Phase 1 (Phase 1) will deliver 30 million gallons per day (mgd) of purified water to Miramar Reservoir; and

WHEREAS, the purified water produced by Phase 1 must be retained in the reservoir for

at least 60 days before it is withdrawn and reused as water supply; and

WHEREAS, achieving the 60-day retention time requires operating the Miramar

Reservoir at a higher level than it does today, which will reduce operational flexibility and

require that current reservoir inflows be minimized; and

WHEREAS, redirection of residuals that result from operating the Miramar Water

Treatment Plant (WTP) away from Miramar Reservoir into the sewer system will increase

efficiency at the WTP by restoring reservoir operational flexibility and reducing reservoir

inflows; and

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WHEREAS, the City desires to update the Capital Improvement Budget to add a new stand-alone project to build the Miramar WTP Residuals Redirection to reroute the residuals into the sewer; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to appropriate and expend \$200,000 from the Capital Improvement Budget for the purpose of starting design of the Miramar WTP Residuals Redirection; and WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to add CIP S-23012, Miramar WTP Residuals Redirection, to the Capital Improvement Program.
- The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the FY Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP S-23012, Miramar WTP Residuals Redirection, and to appropriate and expend \$200,000 from Fund 700010, Water Utility CIP for the purpose of starting design of the Miramar WTP Residuals Redirection.
