A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXPANDING BEREAVEMENT LEAVE FOR UNREPRESENTED EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, San Diego (Charter) sections 11.1 and 290 provide, in pertinent part, that the San Diego City Council (City Council) annually adopts a Salary Ordinance, establishing salaries and wages of all officers and employees of the City of San Diego (City), in accordance with Charter sections 70 and 130; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes paid bereavement leave to unrepresented employees under the terms set forth in the Salary Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2022, California Governor Gavin Newsom signed
Assembly (AB) 1949 into law, which was effective on January 1, 2023. AB 1949 entitles
employees who have been employed by the City for at least 30 days to take the equivalent of up
to five days of unpaid bereavement leave upon the death of a covered family member (FEHA
Bereavement Leave); and

WHEREAS, the use of FEHA Bereavement Leave runs concurrently with the use of the City's existing paid bereavement leave benefit. Employees may use any accrued leave or go unpaid once their paid bereavement leave allocation for each fiscal year has been exhausted. In addition, this action will authorize employees to use FEHA Bereavement Leave within 12 months of the death of each covered family member; and

WHEREAS, the proposed terms related to eligibility, hourly totals, documentation, and guidelines for usage of paid bereavement leave and FEHA Bereavement Leave for unrepresented employees is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR 314955; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the expanded terms for unrepresented employees to use bereavement leave, presented to the Council and on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-<u>314955</u>, is approved, and takes effect upon the date of final passage of this Resolution.
