A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FISCAL YEAR 2024 PARK AND RECREATION CENTER FUNDS AND OPPORTUNITY FUND BUDGETS.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has developed proposed budgets for Recreation Center Funds and Opportunity Fund Budgets after taking into consideration recommendations and requests of the community; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2022 the Council of the City of San Diego, through Resolution R-313898, approved the addition of a new Opportunity Fund fee that applies to permitted events, facilities used by sports leagues, room and pool rentals, and on-going recreation-based business operations by commercial and non-profit entities which fall within one of the exceptions to Proposition 26. The Opportunity Fund fee is in addition to applicable park use and facility rental fees; and

WHEREAS, collection of fees for the Opportunity Fund started after July 1, 2022, and Recreation Center Funds that serve communities of concern will have funding added from these fees; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend Recreation Center Funds in Fiscal Year

2024 as detailed in Attachment A: Proposed Fiscal Year 2024 Recreation Center Funds Budgets,

attached to the Staff Report.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to

approve and appropriate the transfer of Opportunity Fund fees into identified Recreation Center

Funds in Fiscal Year 2024 as detailed in Attachment B: Opportunity Fund Allocations, attached

to the Staff Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the estimated Fiscal Year 2023 Carry Forward Funds

will be available to appropriate during Fiscal Year 2024 and are subject to change upon

completion of the City's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

Recreation Center Funds generated from permit fees that fall within one of the exceptions to

Proposition 26 in any geographic area regardless of where collected to promote equity in Parks

and Recreation Department-wide recreation programs.
