DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 27 2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT INCREASING THE NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNTS AT WHICH THE MAYOR IS AUTHORIZED TO AWARD CONTRACTS FOR SLURRY SEAL GROUPS 2324, 2325, AND 2326 IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301(C).

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) is considering increasing the not to exceed amount at which the Mayor is authorized to execute contracts to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for proposed Slurry Seal Group 2324, 2325 and 2326 projects to include additional striping related to new and improved bicycle lanes (Projects); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code section 21000 - 21189.70.10), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000 - 15387) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, under that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 - 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c) (Existing Facilities) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effects of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Projects as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Projects will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Projects consist of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and will involve existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, as well as other alterations such as the addition of bicycle facilities, including but not limited to bicycle parking, bicycle-share facilities and bicycle lanes; and


WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1 The City Council has determined that the Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301(c) (Existing Facilities).
2. The City Council has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.


