A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING ADDENDUM NO. 1062231 TO PROGRAM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 30330/304032/SCH NO. 2004651076 FOR EXPOSITION WAY -PROJECT NO. PRJ-1062231.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Planning Department conducted a comprehensive plan update to the Otay Mesa Community Plan that included a General Plan Amendment, rescission of the Otay Mesa Development District, adoption of a Rezone Ordinance to replace the Otay Mesa Development District with citywide zoning and the creation of two new Community Plan Implementation Overlay Zones, amendments to the City's Land Development Code, and an update of the Otay Mesa Community Plan Public Facilities Financing Plan (Project); and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2014, the San Diego City Council adopted Resolution No. R-308810 certifying the Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Project No. 30330/304032, SCH No. 2004651076, adopting Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations, and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2022, Exposition Way submitted an application to the Development Services Department for approval of a General Plan Amendment, Community Plan

Amendment, and Rezone for the Exposition Way (Project No. PRJ-1062231), as well as approval of minor technical changes or additions to the Project; and

WHEREAS, State CEQA Guidelines section 15164(a) allows a lead agency to prepare an Addendum to a final Environmental Impact Report if such Addendum meets the requirements of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the information contained in the final Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) No. 30330/304032/SCH No. 2004651076 along with the Addendum thereto, including any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this City Council prior to making a decision on the Project.

2. That there are no substantial changes proposed to the Project and no substantial changes with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken that would require major revisions in the PEIR No. 30330/304032/SCH No. 2004651076 for the Project.

3. That no new information of substantial importance has become available showing that the Project would have any significant effects not discussed previously in the PEIR No. 30330/304032/SCH No. 2004651076 or that any significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in the PEIR No. 30330/304032/SCH No. 2004651076.

4. That no new information of substantial importance has become available showing that mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible are in fact feasible

which would substantially reduce any significant effects, but that the Project proponents decline to adopt, or that there are any considerable different mitigation measures or alternatives not previously considered which would substantially reduce any significant effects, but that the Project proponents decline to adopt.

5. That pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15164, only minor technical changes or additions are necessary, and therefore, the City Council adopts Addendum to PEIR No. 30330/304032/SCH No. 2004651076 with respect to the project, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the Project.
