A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT AND TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM CYCLE 11 GRANT FUNDING FOR MID-CITY AND SAN YSIDRO TRAFFIC SIGNAL TIMING AND COMMUNICATION UPGRADES, AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, President Biden signed the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), into law on November 15, 2021 and under the IIJA, the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), codified as 23 U.S.C §148, is a core federal-aid program to States for the purpose of reducing fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans' Division of Local Assistance, which manages California's local agency share of HSIP funds, awarded \$1,018,250 in HSIP grant funding to the City of San Diego on March 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this award of \$1,018,250 of HSIP funds from Caltrans will be used to upgrade traffic signal and communication hardware to improve traffic signal timing and optimize operations at 101 signalized intersections in Mid-City, San Ysidro, and nearby communities in order to improve air quality and traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. The Mayor or designee is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure HSIP Cycle 11 grant funding from Caltrans in an amount not to exceed \$1,018,250 for CIP A-IL.00002, Install T/S Interconnect Systems, of which \$955,452.43 is for B-16032, TSCMP Group 1 Implementation, and \$62,797.57 is for B-17130, Montezuma Road Communications Upgrade, and to execute a grant agreement with Caltrans to secure the funding.
- 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend HSIP Cycle 11 grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$1,018,250 contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.
- 4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget in CIP A-IL.00002, Install T/S Interconnect Systems, (B-16032, TSCMP Group 1 Implementation, and B-17130, Montezuma Road Communications Upgrade), and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,018,250.00 within fund 600001, Grant Fund State, of which \$955,452.43 is for B-16032, TSCMP Group 1 Implementation, and \$62,797.57 is for B-17130, Montezuma Road Communications Upgrade, contingent upon the Chief Financial
