A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 179 PASS-THROUGH GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000,000 FOR STARTUP COSTS RELATED TO EMERGENCY SHELTER FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

WHEREAS, the State of California approved Assembly Bill 179 titled "Budget Act of 2022" which included an allocation of \$2,000,000 to the City of San Diego for startup costs for emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence (Grant); and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2023, pursuant to Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 52 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the City of San Diego's Grant Review Team authorized an application for the Grant; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) authorized the pass-through subaward of the Grant to the City in March 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City's Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department is developing a program that provides a safe space and critical resources for victims of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the proposed shelter for victims of domestic violence will use a traumainformed, person-centered approach and will offer case management, basic needs assistance, and resource referrals that meet the needs of each individual; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend a pass-through grant from the California Office of Emergency Services in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, upon appropriation, the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor, manage, and ensure compliance with the grant agreement, and, when required, to develop, advertise, negotiate, and award contracts to third parties to implement the grant agreement.
