A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT RATIFICATION OF THE EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH HIG DOWNTOWN INVESTMENTS LLC FOR THE TEMPORARY RELOCATION OF INDIVIDUALS SHELTERED AT GOLDEN HALL IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15269(c).

statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to ratify the emergency contract

between the City and HIG Downtown Investments LLC in the amount of \$151,371.13 for the

temporary relocation of individuals sheltered at Golden Hall located at 202 C Steet, San Diego,

California 92101 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has determined that the Project'is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c) (Emergency Projects); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c) (Emergency Projects) which exempts specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c).
