A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF AN ALLOCATION NOTIFICATION AND AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND ALL RELATED ACTIONS, TO SUPPORT THE NEEDS OF REFUGEE STUDENTS AT SAN DIEGO SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Budget Act of 2022 (Section 19.56(k)(55) of Assembly Bill 179, Chapter 249, Statutes of 2022), the City of San Diego (City) was awarded \$1,700,000 from the California Department of Social Services to work with San Diego area schools to support the needs of refugee students (Allocation Notification and Award); and

WHEREAS, the \$1,700,000 in funds shall be available for expenditure until June 30, 2026, contingent upon the availability of funds; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established require the recipient's Governing Body to certify by resolution the acceptance of the Allocation Notification and Award, including the attestation that the funds will be used for the purposes for which they have been appropriated and allocated; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to receive and accept the Allocation Notification and Award; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to expend the Allocation Notification and Award by donating the funds to the San Diego Unified School District after execution of a reimbursement agreement on terms and conditions consistent with the General Requirements of the Allocation Notification and Award; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to accept, receive, and expend an award from the California Department of Social Services for an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000 to work with San Diego area schools to support the needs of refugee students.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council certifies that the City has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the assurances, general requirements, award-specific requirements, and certification in the Allocation Notification and Award, including the Appropriation Reference and Program, 5180-151M-0001 Program – 4275028.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure the award funds from the California Department of Social Services for its stated purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to conduct all negotiations, sign, and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, any agreements, amendments, contracts, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the Allocation Notification and Award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000 in award funding from Fund 600001 Grant Fund-State to support the needs of refugee students in San Diego area

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schools if the award funds are secured, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer

furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to

enter into a reimbursement agreement with the San Diego Unified School District and to advance

up to \$1,700,000 in award funds to the San Diego Unified School District to support the needs of

refugee students in San Diego area schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to

negotiate a reimbursement agreement with the San Diego Unified School District and accept it

on terms and conditions deemed by the Mayor, or his designee, to be reasonable and in the best

interest of the City, and to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, a reimbursement agreement,

and all other agreements and documents necessary to complete the reimbursement agreement of

an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000, in award funds; and to transfer an amount not to exceed

\$1,700,000 in award funds to the San Diego Unified School District pursuant to the negotiated

reimbursement agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish

a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.
