A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR, RECEIPT, AND EXPENDITURE OF HOUSING ACCELERATION GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE, CITY/PUBLIC PROPERTY AFFORDABLE HOME DEVELOPMENT MASTER PLAN, CITY OF SAN DIEGO PLANNING 101 CAMPAIGN, MISSING MIDDLE HOUSING DESIGN, AND PILOT DIF CREDIT PROGRAM FOR AFFORDABLE HOMES.

WHEREAS, up to \$16 million of the Regional Early Action Planning Grants of 2021 (REAP 2.0) allocated funding for San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) from the California Department of Housing and Community Development is available to local jurisdictions through the Housing Acceleration Program (HAP) Cycle 2 Call for Projects; and

WHEREAS, the HAP Cycle 2 provides funding for planning activities that facilitate transit-oriented development and accelerate housing production; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego adopted a Climate Action Plan (CAP) in a public meeting on August 2, 2022 that includes measures to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions to 1990 levels by 2020 and achieves further reductions beyond 2020 consistent with adopted regional or local GHG emissions reduction targets; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego wishes to received grant funding from SANDAG; and WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the City of San Diego, as follows:

- That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount of up to \$650,000 in HAP Cycle 2 grant funds for the Mid-City Community Plan Update.
- 2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount of up to \$650,000 in HAP Cycle 2 grant funds for the City Affordable Home Development Master Plan.
- 3. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount of up to \$500,000 in HAP Cycle 2 grant funds for the City of San Diego Inclusive Public Engagement Training Campaign.
- 4. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount of up to \$500,000 in HAP Cycle 2 grant funds for the Missing Middle Home Design Plans.
- 5. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount of up to \$2,500,000 in HAP Cycle 2 grant funds for the Pilot DIF Credit Program for Affordable Homes.
- 6. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$4,800,000 if the grant funding is secured.
- 7. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds not to exceed \$400,000 from the General Plan Maintenance Fund 200728 (\$100,000 for the Mid-City Community Plan Update and \$300,000 the City Affordable Home Master Plan)

for the purpose of funding grant match requirements for the Project if grant funding

is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if a grant award is made by SANDAG to fund any

of these projects, the City of San Diego commits to providing the match amounts per project as

listed in the grant application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if a grant award is made by SANDAG, the City of

San Diego authorizes staff to accept the grant funds, execute the grant agreement(s) with no

exceptions in substantially the same form as provided with the Call for Projects, and complete

the Project(s); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, the City of San Diego understands and agrees to

comply with all applicable REAP 2.0 requirements imposed by the California Department of

Housing and Development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, the City of San Diego understands and agrees that

SANDAG shall have no liability for costs that may arise associated with the Project(s), which are

not included in the grant agreement(s), including but not limited to costs stemming from claims,

litigation, changes in law, or force majeure events.
