A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN
KEKOA YOUNG AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ET AL.

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2020, Kekoa Young filed suit against the City of San Diego, et al., alleging personal injuries arising from a motor vehicle accident that occurred on July 11, 2019, on Myrtle Avenue at the intersection with Utah Street, San Diego. The suit is entitled *Kekoa Young v. City of San Diego, et al.*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2020-00017371-CU-PA-CTL (Litigation); and

WHEREAS, in Closed Session on July 31, 2023, the City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9; Nays, None; and Absent, None; approved the Settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below;

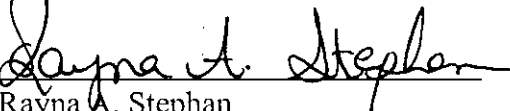
BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council:

1) Authorizes the Mayor or his designee to pay the sum of \$2,300,000.00 from Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs, and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from this Litigation; and

2) Authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,300,000.00 from Public Liability Fund No. 720045, for the purpose of settling these claims.
