A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVING WATER RATE INCREASES CONSISTENT WITH A COST OF SERVICE STUDY AND PASS-THROUGH INCREASES IN THE WHOLESALE COST OF WATER CHARGED BY THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15273.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department, which operates the Water Utility and the Water Utility Fund, an enterprise fund, is seeking to increase the water rates that it charges customers consistent with a cost of service study and the pass-through increase in the wholesale cost of water charged by the San Diego County Water Authority for calendar year 2024 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21189.70.10, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 21084 states that CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., title 14, §§ 15000 to 15387 (CEQA Guidelines)) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, under that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15273; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written

record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15273 because it

involves the establishment, modification, and approval of rates, tolls, fares or other charges by

the City which are necessary for meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and

fringe benefits; purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment or materials; meeting reserve needs

and requirements; and obtaining funds for capital projects necessary to maintain service within

existing service areas; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Project is statutorily

exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15273.
