A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO GRANT TO SUPPORT THE EMERGENCY SHELTER FOR SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, the Board of Supervisors (Board) of the County of San Diego (County) established allocations of federal funding from the American Rescue Plan of 2021 (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of ARPA funding is to help expand emergency housing options including capacity for domestic violence, human trafficking, and sexual assault victims; and

WHEREAS, the County is collaborating with the City of San Diego (City) and entering into a Subrecipient Grant Agreement to transfer ARPA funding to the City for up to \$6,200,000 to fund capital improvements and up to two years of operations of an emergency shelter for survivors of domestic violence, human trafficking, and sexual assault (County Grant); and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2023, the grants review team of the City approved the County Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or

designee, is authorized to enter into the Subrecipient Grant Agreement with the County in an

amount not to exceed \$6,200,000 to fund capital improvements and up to two years of operations

of an emergency shelter for survivors of domestic violence, human trafficking, and sexual

assault.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, is

authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend the County Grant funds in an amount not to exceed

\$6,200,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to take all

necessary action to administer, monitor, manage, and ensure compliance with the Subrecipient

Grant Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to negotiate,

enter into, and execute contracts with third parties to implement the Subrecipient Grant

Agreement or use of the County Grant funds, as appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish

a special interest-bearing account for the County Grant, if required, the proceeds of which will be

used for any eligible uses outlined in the Subrecipient Grant Agreement.
