A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY FORCES TO COMPLETE FOUR IN-HOUSE PROJECTS FOR REPAIRS OF CORRUGATED METAL STORMWATER PIPES AND EXPENDITURE OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BUDGET FUNDS FOR CITY FORCE WORK RELATED EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, failing Corrugated Metal Pipes (CMP) in the City of San Diego stormwater collection system are the primary cause of stormwater drainage system failure requiring the City to implement costly emergency repairs; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to repair and replace all CMP to prevent costly emergency repairs, major transportation interruptions, and public liability costs; and

WHEREAS, in June 2018, the Office of the City Auditor conducted a performance audit of the City of San Diego Stormwater Department (Department) and recommended that the Department: (1) use City forces to replace CMP more quickly and efficiently; and (2) complete an analysis to support plans to optimize the size of the Department's in-house CMP repair crew; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Department reviewed existing CMP segments to assess repair options for individual pipe segments; and

WHEREAS, Department analysis identified 8.48 miles of CMP out of a total of 32.2 miles with the appropriate characteristics for in-house repair or replacement by City forces; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) previously approved a second stormwater drainpipe repair crew by Ordinance Number O-21348 and the Department is positioned to perform one mile of CMP replacement per year, in-house by City forces and to

fully replace the identified 8.48 miles of CMP thereby necessitating in-house Capital Improvements Program (CIP) projects to replace the identified CMP; and

WHEREAS, four in-house CIP projects are in locations that experience frequent flooding due to an inadequate and aged drainage system; and

WHEREAS, the four in-house CIP projects and estimated project cost are listed below and are located within Council Districts 3, 4, and 7 and the Uptown, Encanto Neighborhoods, and Serra Mesa Community Plan Areas:

WHEREAS, the implementation of the in-house CIP projects will alleviate flooding and erosion problems in these Community Plan areas; and

WHEREAS, funding for the in-house CIP projects is currently available in CIP ACA00001, Flood Resilience Infrastructure, within fund 400881, Debt Funded General Fund CIP; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code Section 22.3105 requires Council approval for the use of City forces on a public works project if the cost of using such forces exceeds \$500,000 and the cost of using City forces for these in-house CIP projects will exceed this

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amount; and

· WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to use City Force Work to complete the following in-house CIP

projects to conduct repairs or replacement of Corrugated Metal Pipes:

1. Health Center Dr SD SWD

2. Hawthorn St and 3rd Ave SD SWD

3. San Jacinto Dr SD SWD

4. 1st Ave at Brookes Ave SD SWD;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the

Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to expend funds not to exceed \$7,554,973.62 from

CIP ACA00001, Flood Resilience Infrastructure, Fund 400881, Debt Funded General Fund

CIP, for City Force Work related expenses for the four in-house CIP projects to conduct

repairs to Corrugated Metal Pipes.
