A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS OR NOTES BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR IRIS AT SAN YSIDRO APARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, one or more notice(s) of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds were timely published in accordance with said section 147(f); and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2023, the San Diego Housing Commission (Housing Commission) held on behalf of the City, under authority delegated to the Housing Commission by the City, a public hearing in accordance with all applicable law and an opportunity was provided at such hearing for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; and
