A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S  
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION GRANT TO SECURE FUNDING  
FOR THE ACCESSIBILITY SAFETY PLAN FOR  
INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES IN DISADVANTAGED  
COMMUNITIES AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Accessibility Safety Plan for Individuals with Disabilities in  
Disadvantaged Communities (Plan) includes utilizing a consultant to update the City's right-of-  
way self-evaluation and transition plan in many historically disadvantaged communities located  
south of Interstate 8; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) provides grant  
funding for active transportation programs through the Active Transportation Grant (ATP Cycle  
6) Regional Competition; and

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 requires municipalities to  
complete a self-evaluation and transition plan for accessible pedestrian networks; and

WHEREAS, the Plan will utilize a consultant to update data for Plan-area pedestrian  
routes in the public right-of-way and identify all accessibility-related infrastructure and barriers  
along pedestrian networks; and

WHEREAS, City staff determined that the Plan is eligible for \$1,238,540.00 in ATP  
Cycle 6 grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the City to match grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$262,000; and


WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to make applications to the California Department of Transportation to secure grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$1,238,540.00, and to execute a grant agreement with the California Department of Transportation for the purposes of creating safe and accessible pedestrian pathways in disadvantaged communities in accordance with City's Accessibility Safety Plan for Individuals with Disabilities in Disadvantaged Communities; and
2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend Accessibility Safety Plan for Individuals with Disabilities in Disadvantaged Communities grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$1,238,540.00 contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement; and
3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$262,000 from General Fund 100000 for the purpose of funding grant match requirements; and

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.


