A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE TASK ORDER MODIFICATION FOR TASK ST1916-013 UNDER JOB ORDER CONTRACT K-20-1916-JOC-3 WITH CTE INC. FOR CITYWIDE STREET LIGHTING/TRAFFIC SIGNALS GROUP 1950 IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 AND 15302.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize a task order modification for Task ST1916-013 as part of Job Order Contract K-20-1916-JOC-3 with CTE, Inc. for City Street Lighting/Traffic Signals Group 1950 to increase the not-to-exceed value of the contract by \$1,062,946.04 and add 75 additional street light poles and fixtures for replacement to the scope of Task Order ST1916-013 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21189.70.10), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, sections 15000-15387) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, under that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities), 15302

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(Replacement or Reconstruction of Existing Structures and Facilities), and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and will involve existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, and other similar alterations which will not create additional automobile lanes; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the authorization of the Project, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (Existing Facilities), 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction of Existing Structures and Facilities), and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA

Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
