A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND AXON ENTERPRISE, INC.
FOR BODY WORN CAMERA AND DIGITAL EVIDENCE
MANAGEMENT SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) strives to advance the highest levels of public safety, trust, and professionalism by strengthening community partnerships through fair and impartial policing while fostering employee enrichment and growth; and

WHEREAS, the use of body worn cameras (BWCs) has proven effective in reducing violent confrontations and complaints against officers. BWCs provide additional documentation of police and public encounters and are an important tool for collecting evidence and maintaining public trust; and

WHEREAS, BWCs and Digital Evidence Management services are a tool to demonstrate SDPD's commitment to transparency, ensure the accountability of its members, increase the public's trust in officers, and protect its members from unjustified complaints of misconduct; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2023, the City of San Diego (City) issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for BWCs and Digital Evidence Management services, including hardware, storage, licensing, training, and ongoing maintenance support services; and

WHEREAS, the Digital Evidence Management service is to store, impound, retrieve, and review all videos recorded by a BWC and all photo evidence collected on a secured platform accessible to SDPD personnel with approved security clearance; and

WHEREAS, after a comprehensive competitive process, the City selected Axon Enterprise, Inc. (Axon) to provide the BWC and Digital Evidence Management services; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2023, the Council of the City of San Diego approved Body Worn Cameras and Digital Evidence Management technologies pursuant to the Transparent and Responsible Use of Surveillance Technology Ordinance in Resolution R-315195; and

WHEREAS, SDPD seeks to enter into an agreement with Axon for a BWC System Solution, including Body Worn Cameras, Digital Evidence Management services, licensing, training, and ongoing maintenance support services for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$12,100,000; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement between the City and Axon Enterprise, Inc. to provide a complete BWC System Solution, including Body Worn Cameras, Digital Evidence Management services, licensing, training, and ongoing maintenance support services in an amount not to exceed \$12,100,000 for a term of five years, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-**315246**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$12,100,000 from the Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) fund (200722) to provide a complete BWC System Solution, including Body Worn Cameras, Evidence Management services, licensing, training, and ongoing maintenance support services over the five-year term of the Contract, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent

upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
