A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE UPDATED 2023-2024 STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 22.1901 provides that the City of San Diego (City) Government Affairs Department (Department) is responsible for planning, recommending, coordinating, and administering a state and federal legislative program for the City in accordance with legislative guidelines established by the San Diego City Council (Council); and

WHEREAS, the Department provides state and federal legislative coordination, serves as the City's liaison on state and federal governmental matters, and, in consultation with other City departments, the City's lobbyists, and others, develops for Council approval the City's legislative programs for the state and federal legislative sessions; and

WHEREAS, by San Diego Resolution R-314558 (Dec. 20, 2022), the Council approved the 2023-2024 State and Federal Legislative Platform; and

WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 State and Federal Legislative Platform defines the City's Guiding Principles and Policy Priorities, and provides a means to advance and protect the City's interests on issues at the federal and state levels; and

WHEREAS, the three Guiding Principles are (1) to promote social justice, equity, and inclusive economic development, (2) to preserve local control, and (3) to support fiscal stability and funding opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Guiding Principles and the Policy Priorities under each principle allow for flexibility so that the Department, working with other City officials and the City's legislative

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advocates, can be proactive and quickly respond within the defined, established boundaries to address legislative, regulatory, administrative, and budget issues that arise during the year; and

WHEREAS, Department staff propose an update to the 2023-2024 State and Federal Legislative Platform to account for changes to City priorities based on updates that have occurred in the 2023 legislative session and input from the Office of the Mayor, Council, and City Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the updated 2023-2024 State and Federal Legislative Platform is approved, as presented to and amended by the Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council authorizes the Department staff to take any necessary actions to address and implement the policies set forth in the updated 2023-2024 State and Federal Legislative Platform.
