A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS BOARD, AND REDESIGNATION OF CERTAIN MEMBER SEATS.

WHEREAS, the International Affairs Board (Board) is established in San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 00, section 26.22, with its powers and duties set forth in section 26.23; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 26.23, the Board shall: recommend and participate in programs to promote the City of San Diego's (City) standing as a global city, and establish mutually beneficial ties with peoples, governments, organizations, and institutions around the world to promote the global character of San Diego; advise the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego (Council) on how international issues and policies impact San Diego; advise the Mayor and Council regarding diplomatic and protocol activities with the international community, and engage in programs to foster friendly relations, promote San Diego's global economic competitive advantages, build relationships, and advance cultural awareness and better understanding between the City's diverse neighborhoods and the broader world; and confer with the San Diego International Sister Cities Corporation and make appropriate recommendations to the Mayor and Council concerning the establishment of additional formal and informal global relationships; and

WHEREAS, the Board consists of 17 members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, consisting of nine community members and eight civic organization members, who shall serve two-year terms, may serve a maximum of four consecutive terms, and shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the nine community members shall be residents of San Diego County and qualified by training, experience, or interest in international affairs; and

WHEREAS, the nine community members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than five members expire in any year; and

WHEREAS, the eight civic organization members shall represent civic organizations with international affairs involvement or expertise; and

WHEREAS, the eight civic organization members shall be appointed in order to stagger the members' terms; and

WHEREAS, current Board member, Leila Naderi, previously was appointed to a civic organization member seat pursuant to San Diego Resolution R-314110 (May 23, 2022); and

WHEREAS, Leila Naderi's appointment incorrectly filled a seat held by a community member; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor now seeks Council confirmation of appointments and reappointments to the Board and redesignation of certain member seats; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,
