A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A SIDE LETTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE CALIFORNIA TEAMSTERS LOCAL 911, TO AMEND ARTICLE 80 OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RELATED TO PAID SICK LEAVE FOR HOURLY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, by San Diego Resolution R-314186 (June 23, 2022), the San Diego City Council approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of San Diego and the California Teamsters Local 911 (Local 911) regarding terms and conditions of employment for employees represented by Local 911 for fiscal years 2023 and 2024; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2023, Governor Gavin Newsom approved Senate Bill 616, which will be effective on January 1, 2024. SB 616 requires employers to provide their employees up to 40 hours or five days, whichever is more, of accrued paid sick leave each year or 12-month period; and allow employees to accrue up to a maximum of 80 hours or ten days, whichever is more, of paid sick leave; and

WHEREAS, the City and Local 911 entered into a side letter agreement (Agreement) to amend Article 80 of the MOU related to paid sick leave for hourly employees to comply with SB 616; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement must be approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the Council to take effect, in accordance with Charter section 11.2; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Agreement between the City and Local 911 to amend Article 80 of the MOU related to paid sick leave for hourly employees, presented to the City Council and on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **315277**, is approved, and takes effect upon the date of final passage of this resolution.
