A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A REVENUE BOND BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR CASA NUEVA.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$12,968,761 principal amount of a multifamily housing revenue bond (Bond) to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of Casa Nueva, a multifamily affordable housing project in the City of San Diego (City) described in the Notice of Public Hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bond to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Code) requires that the Bond be approved by the City Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, one or more notices of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bond were timely published in accordance with the applicable United States Treasury Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held by the San Diego Housing Commission on April 6, 2023, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their

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views on the issuance of the Bond and on the nature and location of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Resolution based on the information provided by Housing Commission staff, and verified by the Housing Commission's General Counsel, with the understanding that this information is sufficient to allow for a proper and complete analysis of this matter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council, as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, as follows:

- 1. The issuance of the Bond by the Authority is approved.
- 2. The City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the Bond or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bond. No moneys of the City will be pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bond.
