AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 63.0120 TO ADD A NIGHTTIME CURFEW AT PASATIEMPO NEIGHBORHOOD PARK (UNDEVELOPED) AND PASATIEMPO PARK WEST OPEN SPACE.

WHEREAS, public parks in the City of San Diego (City) are intended for the enjoyment of the general public, including families with children and, in an effort to curtail violations of public laws during nighttime hours, the City previously established nighttime curfews at certain public parks; and

WHEREAS, the nighttime curfews in City parks serve as an effective means for the Police Department to minimize illegal use of the parks and prevent criminal and unsanitary activities, resulting in a safer environment for general public use; and

WHEREAS, Pasatiempo Neighborhood Park (undeveloped) and Pasatiempo Park West Open Space do not currently have a nighttime curfew; and

WHEREAS, the Allied Gardens Recreation Council and the City's Parks and Recreation Board unanimously approved the installation of signage at Pasatiempo Park and Open Space limiting the public from dusk till dawn; and

WHEREAS, the City's Community and Neighborhood Services Committee has voted to recommend adding a nighttime curfew to Pasatiempo Neighborhood Park (undeveloped) and Pasatiempo Park West Open Space; and

WHEREAS, numerous incidents of illegal and illicit behaviors have been witnessed or observed by the community and residents in and around Pasatiempo Neighborhood Park (undeveloped) and Pasatiempo Park West Open Space including underage drinking, drug deals, drug use, noise disturbances, vandalism, graffiti, and people operating their vehicles after consuming alcohol or marijuana; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego desires to alleviate the negative impacts of persons frequenting Pasatiempo Neighborhood Park (undeveloped) and Pasatiempo Park West Open Space during the nighttime hours by enacting a nighttime curfew at the parks; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 6, Article 3, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 63.0120, to read as follows:

§63.0120 Nighttime Curfew for Certain Public Parks and the Spruce Street Pedestrian Bridge


(a) through (d) [No change in text.]

(e) It is unlawful for any person to be on the portions of Pasatiempo Neighborhood Park (undeveloped) and Pasatiempo Park West Open Space depicted in map 63.0120-B from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. between April 1 and October 31 and from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. between November 1 and March 31.
