AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 5 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 26.0501, 26.0502, AND 26.0503, RELATING TO THE COMMUNITY FOREST ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 5, sections 26.0501 through 26.0503 (Municipal Code) established the Community Forest Advisory Board (Board) to advise the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego (Council) on policy issues relating to urban forestry; and

WHEREAS, under the Municipal Code, the Board's duties include suggesting mechanisms that establish and maintain a healthy urban forest for City residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, under the Municipal Code, the Board shall consist of 15 members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, under the Municipal Code, nine of the members shall be from a list of two nominations submitted by each Councilmember to represent their district; and

WHEREAS, under the Municipal Code, the Mayor shall also appoint five members who shall be a landscape architect; a certified arborist; urban forester; a horticulturist/nursery industry representative; a representative from a non-profit organization or governmental agency involved with forestry; and an artist; and

WHEREAS, under the Municipal Code, in January of each year, the Mayor may designate one member as Chair, and in the absence of such designation the Board shall, on or after February 15, select a Chair from among its members; and

WHEREAS, City staff have been informed that the current Municipal Code requirements for this Board have limited the Board's ability to meet quorum and carry out the vision of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to amend the Municipal Code to reduce the total membership of the Board and change the appointment of the Chair to better enable the Board to meet quorum and carry out its duties and functions; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending sections 26.0501, 26.0502, and 26.0503, to read as follows:

§26.0501 Purpose and Intent

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Community Forest Advisory Board to serve in an advisory capacity to the Mayor and City Council on policy issues relating to urban forestry. The Board's duties include suggesting mechanisms that establish and maintain a healthy urban forest for City residents and visitors.

§26.0502 Composition of the Community Forest Advisory Board

The Community Forest Advisory Board shall consist of thirteen members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. The Mayor shall appoint nine members, one each from nominations submitted by each Councilmember to represent their district.

Additionally, the Mayor shall appoint four members who shall be any of the following: a licensed landscape architect; a certified arborist; urban forester; a representative of the horticulturist/nursery industry; a representative from a non-profit organization involved with forestry as demonstrated in the organization's articles of incorporation, or a governmental agency involved with forestry; or an artist. Members shall serve three-year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. The members shall be appointed such that the terms of not more than five members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be December 31. On or after February 15 of each year, the Board shall select a Chair from among its members. Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place becomes vacant. The Board shall adopt rules and procedures consistent with the law for the conduct of its responsibilities.

§26.0503 Duties and Functions

The Board shall:

- (a) Provide advice and recommendations to the Mayor and City Council on policy issues relating to urban forestry.
- (b) Advocate and formulate proactive urban forestry policies, ordinances, and guidelines.
- (c) [No change in text.]
- (d) Review and comment on the coordination of urban forestry-related policies and programs.
- (e) Network with other boards, agencies, and community residents.

(f) through (i) [No change in text.]

Section 2. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

§26.0501 Purpose and Intent

The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. The Mayor shall appoint one member who shall be designated as Chair and nine members, one each from a list of two nominations submitted by each Councilmember to

represent their district. Additionally, the Mayor shall appoint five four members who shall represent or be any of the following; a licensed landscape architect; a certified arborist/;urban forester; a representative of the horticulturist/nursery industry representative; a representative from a non-profit organization involved with forestry as demonstratedshown in the organization's articles of incorporation, or a governmental agency involved with forestry; and or an artist. The mMembers shall serve three-year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. The members shall be appointed such that the terms of not more than five members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be December 31. During January of each year, the Mayor may designate one member as Chair; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall oon or after February 15 of each year, the Board shall select a Chair from among its members.
