DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 18 2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
THE CONTRACT WITH FOCUS PSYCHOLOGICAL
SERVICES, INC. FOR COMPREHENSIVE PSYCHOLOGICAL
SERVICES.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. In 2019, the City issued a Request for Proposal, No. 10089556-20-B to furnish the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) and San Diego-Fire-Rescue Department (Fire-Rescue) with comprehensive psychological services for their employees and their family members residing in the same household.

B. Based on the results of the competitive bid process, the contract was awarded to Focus Psychological Services, Inc. (Focus). Council approved the contract with Focus for a five-year term in an amount not to exceed \$3,593,450 (Resolution Number RR-312753).

C. The contract expires December 31, 2024. SDPD and Fire-Rescue are in the process of finalizing and issuing another RFP for the next five year contract. The City is seeking a six month extension to allow the required time to complete the RFP process, request Council approval, and award a new contract.

D. On October 7, 2024, the Purchasing Agent certified that the First Amendment to the contract was necessary and strict compliance with another competitive process would be unavailing to ensure that there is no gap in vital psychological services provided to SDPD and Fire-Rescue.

E. SDPD and Fire-Rescue now wishes to extend the contract with Focus for an additional six months.

F. SDPD and Fire-Rescue also wishes to increase the not to exceed amount of the Contract by \$922,345 for a total not to exceed amount of \$4,515,795 over the five and half year term of the Contract through June 30, 2025.

G. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

H. Under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by two-thirds majority vote of the City Council.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:


Section 1. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the First Amendment to the Contract with Focus Psychological Services, Inc., to increase the amount by \$922,345 for a total not to exceed amount of \$4,515,795, and to extend the Contract for six months, through June 30, 2025, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 21899.

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an additional \$922,345 for a total not to exceed amount of \$4,515,795 over the full term of the Contract, \$563,000 from the Police Department Fund (1914), General Fund (100000), and \$359,345 from the Fire-Rescue Fund (1912), General Fund (100000), for the purpose of executing this First Amendment.

Section 3. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
