A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING MID-YEAR REVISIONS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2023, the Mayor approved Resolution No. R-314971, approving the City's Fiscal Year 2024 Budget (2024 Budget); and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2023, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-21675,

entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 and Appropriating the

Necessary Money to Operate the City of San Diego for Fiscal Year 2024" (Appropriation

Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2023, the Department of Finance presented to the City

Council its Fiscal Year 2024 First Quarter Budget Monitoring Report (First Quarter Report); and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2024, the Department of Finance issued its Fiscal Year 2024

Mid-Year Budget Monitoring Report (Mid-Year Report); and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Year Report projects a deficit of approximately \$41.5 million relative to the 2024 Budget as implemented by the Appropriation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Appropriations Ordinance authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to modify appropriations upon adopted Council resolution, provided funding is available for such action and in accordance with funding source guidelines and applicable grant agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the proposed appropriation changes as described below and in accordance with the Mid-Year Report; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to revise the 2024 Budget, as detailed in the Mid-Year Report, as follows:

- 1. Adjust General Fund (100000) expenditure appropriations as follows:
 - Increase expenditure appropriations by up to \$10,000,000 to support
 departments involved in storm recovery efforts following the storm that
 impacted the San Diego region on January 22, 2024.
- 2. Non-General Funds:
 - a. Increase expenditure and revenue appropriations by up to \$3,275,000 in the Central Stores Fund (720040).
 - Increase expenditure appropriations by up to \$3,145,000 in the Environmental Growth 1/3 Fund (200111).
 - c. Increase expenditure and revenue appropriations by up to \$98,000 in the Golf Course Fund (700043).
 - d. Increase expenditure and revenue appropriations by up to \$450,000 in the Major Events Revolving Fund (200214).
 - e. Increase expenditure and revenue appropriations by up to \$1,385,000 in the PETCO Park Fund (200208).
 - f. Increase expenditure appropriations by up to \$383,000 in the Seized
 Assets Federal Treasury Fund (200223).

g. Increase expenditure appropriations by up to \$450,000 in the Transient

Occupancy Tax Fund (200205).
