A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING THE EXPLORATION OF AN ENHANCED INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING DISTRICT, OR SIMILAR ALTERNATIVE FUNDING MECHANISM, TO ASSIST WITH REDEVELOPING A 48.5-ACRE CITY-OWNED SITE IN THE CITY'S MIDWAY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) selected Midway Rising, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (Midway Rising), as the successful respondent to the City of San Diego's (City) Notice of Availability (NOA) and authorized City staff to negotiate and enter into an Exclusive Negotiation Agreement for the redevelopment of a 48.5-acre City-owned site (Site) in the Midway District; and

WHEREAS, Midway Rising's redevelopment proposal for the Site includes 4,250 residential dwelling units (2,000 are which are affordable units), a 16,000 seat entertainment arena, up to 145,000 retail/commercial square footage, and acres of parks/public space; and

WHERAS, in its response to the NOA, Midway Rising proposed the creation of an Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District (EIFD) to capture future increases in tax revenues to help fund public infrastructure improvements necessary for the Site's redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the City's Economic Development and Finance departments would like to investigate funding mechanisms further, including an EIFD or similar alternative funding mechanisms for this Site and potential partnerships with other affected taxing entities; and

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WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), that the Council supports exploring the creation of an Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District, or similar financing mechanism, to assist with redeveloping the 48.5-acre City-owned site in the City's Midway District.
