A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR LOGAN AVENUE AND GARNET AVENUE SERIES CIRCUIT UPGRADES AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act (Act) that was signed into law on December 29, 2022, made \$2,982,285,641 available for Economic Development Initiatives for Community Project Funding (CPF) that is awarded and administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the Logan Avenue and Garnet Avenue Series Circuit Upgrades Projects (Projects) updates the outdated series circuit system to an updated parallel lighting system, improving mobility, accessibility, and safety for both pedestrians and vehicular traffic along Logan Avenue and Garnet Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding will be used for the design phase of each Project, as well as a portion of the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to apply to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to secure an Economic Development Initiative/ Community Project Funding grant in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 for CIP AIH00002, Street Light Circuit Upgrades (B24123, Garnet Ave Series Circuit Conversion) and in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for CIP AIH00002, Street Light Circuit Upgrades (B24122, Logan Ave Series Circuit Conversion), and to execute a grant agreement with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to support design and construction for the Projects; and

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend Economic Development Initiative/ Community Project Funding (EDI/CPF) grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer; and


3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required; and

4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget in CIP AIH00002, Street Light Circuit Upgrades (B24123, Garnet Ave Series Circuit Conversion), and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 within Fund 600000, GRANT FUND-FEDERAL.

5. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget in CIP AIH00002, Street Light Circuit Upgrades (B24122, Logan Ave

Series Circuit Conversion), and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.00 within Fund 600000, GRANT FUND-FEDERAL.
