A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING EQUIPMENT NETWORK IS CONSISTENT WITH THE ENVIRONMENAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE CITY CLIMATE ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff [including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff], with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, per CEQA Guidelines section 15162 and in compliance with Public Resources Code section 21166, that the Electric Vehicle Charging Equipment Agreement with True Upside Consulting, LLC for the finance, design, construction, and operation of an electric vehicle charging equipment network at municipal sites City-wide (Agreement), is consistent with the Final Program Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) for the City of San Diego Climate Action Plan (CAP) (Project No. 416603/SCH No. 2015021053) which was certified by the City Council on January 4, 2016 (Resolution R-310176), the Addendum to the CAP FEIR for the CAP Consistency Checklist adopted by the City Council on July 19, 2016 (Resolution R-310595), and the Addendum to the CAP FEIR for the 2022 CAP adopted by the City Council on August 10, 2022 (Resolution R-314298).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the electric vehicle charging network will facilitate the development of publicly accessible electric vehicle charging equipment in accordance with the goals and policies of the City's CAP; and the approval of the Agreement is a subsequent

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discretionary action within the scope of the development program evaluated in the CAP FEIR

and is not considered to be a separate project for the purposes of CEQA review pursuant to

CEQA Guidelines Sections 15378(c) and 15060(c)(3).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21166

and CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 there is no substantial change in circumstance, additional

information of substantive importance, or project changes that show the project will have

significant effects not discussed in the CAP FEIR, or that significant effects previously examined

will be substantially more severe than shown in the CAP FEIR, or that this activity would alter

the City's mitigation measures or alternatives as described in the CAP FEIR, so as to warrant

additional environmental review or revisions to the CAP FEIR for this action.
