A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF \$300,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, VICTIM SERVICES BRANCH, FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER PROGRAM, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SAN DIEGO CITY ATTORNEY TO RETROACTIVELY EXECUTE THE GRANT SUBAWARD AGREEMENT, INCLUDING ANY NECESSARY AMENDMENTS, EXTENSIONS, AND RENEWALS.

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2024, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Victim Services Branch, Family Justice Center Program, awarded \$300,000 in grant funds (Grant Award) to the City of San Diego on behalf of Your Safe Place–A Family Justice Center (YSP) within the Office of the City Attorney (City Attorney); and

WHEREAS, the Grant Award will be used to expand YSP's services and programming for clients experiencing abuse and trafficking, provide professional development and training for YSP team members, and support YSP's violence prevention and awareness campaign; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Award is available for encumbrance from April 1, 2024, through March 31, 2026 (Grant Period); and

WHEREAS, Cal OES requires the Council of the City of San Diego certify, by resolution, the City Attorney has authority to enter into the Grant Subaward Agreement (Agreement) and to execute any amendments, extensions, or renewals that may become necessary; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Grant Award from Cal OES, Victim Services Branch, Family Justice Center Program is accepted in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Attorney is authorized to retroactively execute

the Agreement, and execute any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Agreement that may

become necessary for a period of up to five years from Fiscal Year 2024 through and including

Fiscal Year 2029.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) is authorized to

accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$300,000 in Grant Award funds from Cal OES, Victim

Services Branch, Family Justice Center Program, subject to any amendments, extensions, or

renewals, for a period of up to five years from Fiscal Year 2024 through and including Fiscal

Year 2029.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any expenditures to date consistent with the

Agreement are ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the CFO is authorized to establish a special interest-

bearing account for the Grant Award, if required.
