A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SBCS CORPORATION FOR THE OPERATION OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER.

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3016, the Purchasing Agent certified the award of a sole source contract to SBCS Corporation (SBCS) for the operation of a domestic violence shelter; and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2023, the City of San Diego (City) and SBCS entered into an agreement for the operation of a domestic violence shelter (Agreement), with an initial term from November 27, 2023 through June 30, 2024 (Initial Term), and compensation for a total amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 during the Initial Term; and

WHEREAS, the shelter provides safe, low-barrier emergency housing with Housing First principles to at least 126 families with children fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides additional shelter bed capacity to the existing crisis response system through emergency housing and supportive services specific to survivors of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to enter into a First Amendment of the Agreement

(First Amendment) to revise SBCS's compensation during the Initial Term for a total amount not to exceed \$1,124,579, add four one-year options (Option Period) to extend the term of the Agreement for up to four additional years, and add compensation in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 during each Option Period, and to revise the scope of work; and

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WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent has certified the sole source justification for the

First Amendment, based upon the original sole source justification for the Agreement, continues

to exist and SBCS remains the only operator to provide the necessary continuity of service; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2024, the Land Use and Housing Committee recommended the

First Amendment be forwarded to the Council of the City of San Diego for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or

designee, is authorized to execute the First Amendment to revise the compensation for a total

amount not to exceed \$1,124,579 during the Initial Term, adding options to extend the

Agreement for four additional one-year option periods with compensation in an amount not to

exceed \$3,000,000 during each Option Period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

during each Option Period an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000, contingent upon the adoption of

the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the

Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure

are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
