# DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 01 2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE RATIFICATION OF CHANGE ORDERS 5 AND 7 TO DESIGN AND FINISH THE INTERIOR OF THE MODULAR FOOD SERVICE BUILDING ASSOCIATED WITH THE MISSION BAY GOLF COURSE CLUBHOUSE DEMOLITION AND PORTABLE BUILDING INSTALLATION PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15303.

WHEREAS, the proposed activity involves designing and finishing the interior of a modular food service building that was constructed under a construction contract for certain improvements at the Mission Bay Golf Course (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code sections 21000-21189.70.10), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (Cal. Code Regs., Title 14, sections 15000-15387) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEOA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering & Capital Projects Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

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WHEREAS, on July 30, 2024, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project consists of the conversion of small existing structures such as the installation of furnishings, fixtures, finishes, and equipment to accommodate food and beverage service at the Mission Bay Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303.

2. The City Council has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

accordance with CEQA with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego

and the State Clearinghouse in the Office of Planning and Research regarding the Project.
