A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN
NATALIE SALUK AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2022, Natalie Saluk filed a lawsuit in San Diego Superior Court against the City of San Diego, alleging she was injured after she tripped and fell on uneven sidewalk panels in front of 1757 Missouri Street in Pacific Beach. The suit is entitled *Natalie Saluk v. City of San Diego, et al.*, San Diego County Superior Court No. 37-2022-00016078-CU-PO-CTL (the Litigation); and


WHEREAS, in Closed Session on July 29, 2024, the City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, Districts 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, and 9; Nays, Districts 2 and 5; and Absent, District 8, authorized settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below and pursuant to such other terms more fully set forth in the Settlement and Release Agreement;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council:

1. Authorizes the Mayor or his designee to pay the sum of \$150,000.00 from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs, and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from the Litigation;

2. Authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to expend an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045 for the purpose of settling the Litigation.
