A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AS-NEEDED CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH SCS ENGINEERS, INC. TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE GREENHOUSE GAS REGULATIONS AT CITY OF SAN DIEGO LANDFILLS; AND RELATED FUNDING ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. The City of San Diego's (City) Environmental Services Department (ESD) requires the as-needed consulting services of an environmental and engineering consulting firm to provide compliance with applicable local, state, and federal greenhouse gas (GHG) regulations at City landfills (Consulting Services).
- B. In October 2023, in conformance with Administrative Regulation 25.60 and Council Policy 300-07, ESD advertised a request for proposals (RFP) for the Consulting Services and received three proposals.
- C. The City evaluated each proposal, and SCS Engineers, Inc. was determined to be the most qualified and was selected to provide the Consulting Services subject to City Council approval.
- D. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute an agreement with SCS Engineers, Inc., for environmental engineering services related to greenhouse gas regulations at City of San Diego landfills for a period of five (5) years, in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000. under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file with the City Clerk as

- 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 from the Refuse Disposal Fund No. 700039, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the Agreement, contingent upon City Council approval of the annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years, and upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend \$1,000 from the Refuse Disposal Fund No. 700039, for the purpose of executing the Agreement and meeting minimum contract requirements.
