A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE
CLIMATE ADVISORY BOARD.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Climate Advisory Board (Board) is established in San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.40 and 26.41 (Municipal Code) to advise the Mayor and Council on policies and issues related to climate, environment, environmental justice, energy justice, climate equity, sustainability, and energy for the City of San Diego (City) and to assist the City in implementing the Climate Action Plan and attaining the City's stated goals in these areas.

B. Under, the Municipal Code, the Board shall consist of 15 members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. Of the 15 members, the Mayor shall appoint six members, giving preference to those who have expertise in decarbonization, mobility or planning, land use, public health related to climate change, climate or environmental science, finance or economics, those representing labor organizations, the renewable energy industry, environmental or energy justice organizations, zero waste or circular economy, the clean technology industry, youth climate leadership, or citizen of a federally recognized tribe. The Mayor shall appoint the remaining nine members to represent each Council district based on nominations provided by each Councilmember, giving preference to those who have expertise in the areas described above.

C. Members shall serve two-year staggered terms. Each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. All terms must have expiration dates of August 1.

D. The Mayor now seeks Council confirmation of reappointments to the Board.

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.


Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego, based on the Recitals set forth above:
