A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING SUPPORT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SHORT-TERM ACTION PLAN TO REPLACE 614 SHELTER BEDS AT GOLDEN HALL AND THE PAUL MIRABILE CENTER.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. On July 22, 2024, Council asked the Mayor's office and City staff to partner with Council offices and key stakeholders to develop a short-term action plan to address immediate shelter needs and the necessary replacement of shelter beds.
- B. According to the Short-Term Action Plan, presented to Council on September 24, 2024, the City of San Diego currently operates and maintains nearly 2,500 shelter opportunities for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. There remain more than 3,400 individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness in the City.
- C. The City anticipates a reduction of up to 614 shelter beds due to closure of the shelters currently operating at Golden Hall and the Paul Mirabile Center by the end of the year.
- D. On September 24, 2024, Housing Commission and the City's Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department staff presented a Short-Term Action Plan that proposed replacement options for 468 to 688 shelter bed opportunities in the short-term to mitigate the anticipated loss of 614 shelter beds.
- E. Council, Housing Commission, and City staff discussed options including expansion of safe sleeping and safe parking options, diversion and financial assistance, and

increasing non-congregate shelter options for seniors and families. Council further expressed a desire to take action to support the Short-Term Action Plan.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- 1. Confirm support and implementation of the Short-Term Action Plan in a manner that provides shelter and housing options to replace the 614 shelter beds anticipated to close within the next 3 months at the Golden Hall and Paul Mirabile Center shelters and prioritizing the expansion of safe sleeping, safe parking, and underutilized shelter beds throughout the system, diversion and financial assistance, and non-congregate shelter options for seniors and families.
- Request the Mayor's Office, San Diego Housing Commission, and appropriate
 City departments present an update to the Short-Term Action Plan by December 10, 2024.
