A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY'S MANAGEMENT TEAM FOR LABOR RELATIONS TO ENGAGE IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING, AS REQUIRED BY THE MEYERS-MILIAS-BROWN ACT, RELATED TO PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE ADDING WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTIONS.

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. On September 20, 2023, the Office of the City Attorney issued a memorandum (City Att'y MS 2023-8 (Sept. 20, 2023)) which proposed ethical reforms to strengthen the City's governance, promote oversight and accountability, increase transparency, and encourage collegiality, including adding whistleblower protections to the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) to protect whistleblowers from retribution when reporting improper governmental activities.
- B. On March 20, 2024, City Attorney Mara W. Elliott presented proposed Municipal Code amendments adding whistleblower protections to the Council's Rules Committee. The Rules Committee unanimously advanced the proposed SDMC amendments to a second hearing of the Rules Committee with the request that the City Attorney prepare a draft ordinance to add whistleblower protections to the Municipal Code.
- C. On July 24, 2024, the Rules Committee voted 4-1 in favor of forwarding the proposed Municipal Code amendments to the full Council for discussion and consideration.

 Additionally, the City Attorney was requested to work with the City Auditor and the Ethics Commission to draft language, including, but not limited to, the reporting and investigation of cases.

D. The Council has now considered the proposed Municipal Code amendments and wishes to proceed to the required collective bargaining process.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- 1. The City's management team for labor relations is directed to engage in the collective bargaining process on the mandatory subjects of bargaining related to the proposed Municipal Code amendments adding whistleblower protections, which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, as Document No. RR- 315820
- 2. The Council further directs the City's management team to return to the Council for a final determination on the proposed amendments.
