A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF VEHICLES FOR SALE ON SUNSET LANE BETWEEN AVERIL ROAD AND W. SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD, ON W. SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD BETWEEN SMYTHE AVENUE AND AVERIL ROAD, ON BEYER BOULEVARD BETWEEN CORONADO AVENUE AND IRIS AVENUE, AND ON ALVERSON ROAD BETWEEN SUNSET LANE AND W. SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER TITLE 14 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS SECTION 15301.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Council will consider approving the prohibition of parking of vehicles for sale on Sunset Lane between Averil Road and W. San Ysidro Boulevard, on W. San Ysidro Boulevard between Smythe Avenue and Averil Road, on Beyer Boulevard between Coronado Avenue and Iris Avenue, and on Alverson Road between Sunset Lane and W. San Ysidro Boulevard (Project).

B. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), California Public Resources Code (Code) sections 21000-21189.3, provides in Code section 21083 that the California Office of Planning and Research will promulgate, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency will adopt, guidelines for implementation of CEQA. The California Office of Planning and Research promulgated, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resource Agency adopted, the guidelines for implementation of CEQA set forth in Title 14 California Code of Regulations sections 15000 through 15387 (CEQA Guidelines).

C. Code section 21084 requires the CEQA Guidelines to include a list of classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and are exempt from the provisions of CEQA. CEQA Guidelines sections 15260 through 15285 list the statutory CEQA exemptions promulgated by the California Legislature. CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 through 15333 list classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and declared to be exempt from preparation of environmental documents under CEQA.

D. Council has considered the written record related to the Project and all public comments about the potential environmental effects of the Project. The Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (titled “Existing Facilities”) on the basis that the Project involves minor alterations of existing public facilities that will result in negligible or no expansion of use in the operation of the existing public streets.

E. No exception to the application of the categorical exemptions set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project.

F. The Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate.

#### ACTION ITEMS

Based on the Recitals set forth above, the Council resolves as follows:

I. The Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

2. None of the exceptions to the exemptions found in CEQA Guidelines

section 15300.2 would apply.
