AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 34.0112 REGARDING THE CITY'S CANNABIS BUSINESS TAX.

- A. On November 8, 2016, voters in California voted on the statewide initiative titled "Control, Regulate, and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act" (Adult Use Act) which, among other things, legalized the non-medical use and sale of marijuana and marijuana products in the State of California.
- B. Concurrent with the statewide vote on the Adult Use Act, on November 8, 2016, voters in the City of San Diego (City) approved Measure N imposing a gross receipts tax (CBT) on all non-medical cannabis businesses (Cannabis Businesses) to raise revenue for general governmental purposes. Measure N was codified in the San Diego Municipal Code through an amendment to Chapter 3 by adding Article 4, Division 1 (CBT Ordinance).
- C. Commencing December 12, 2016, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) established a CBT of five percent for all Cannabis Businesses under CBT Ordinance section 34.0112(a).
- D. Under CBT Ordinance section 34.0112(b), the Council may at any time change the rate of CBT (CBT Rate) by ordinance for all Cannabis Businesses or establish differing tax rates for different categories of Cannabis Businesses subject to a maximum CBT Rate of 15 percent.
- E. The CBT Rate increased to eight percent commencing July 1, 2019, under section 34.0112(c) of the CBT Ordinance.

- F. In 2017, the City began permitting commercial cultivation, distribution and storage, and production of medical and recreational cannabis and cannabis products, including Cannabis Production Facilities (CPFs) under Ordinance O-20859 (Oct. 17, 2017).
- G. In 2022, the Council amended the CBT Ordinance by adding section 34.0112(d), which reduced the CBT Rate for CPFs from eight percent to two percent. (Ordinance O-21441 (Mar. 9, 2022)). The CBT Rate for all other Cannabis Businesses remained at eight percent.
- H. Based on the Council's authority under section 34.0112(b) of the CBT Ordinance, the City desires that the Council authorize a two percent increase to the CBT Rate (from eight percent to ten percent) for all Cannabis Businesses except CPFs, effective May 1, 2025. The City will maintain the CBT rate charged to CPFs at two percent.
- I. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. That Chapter 3, Article 4, Division 1, section 34.0112 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

## §34.0112 Amount of Business Tax Owed

- (a) Every Operator engaged in Cannabis Business in the City shall pay a

  Cannabis Business Tax at a rate of up to 15 percent of Gross Receipts.

- (c) Commencing on May 1, 2025, except as set forth in subsection

  34.0112(d), the Cannabis Business Tax rate shall be set at ten percent of

Gross Receipts unless the City Council, by ordinance, takes action to set a different tax rate, not to exceed 15 percent of Gross Receipts.

(d) [No change in text.]

Section 2. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 3. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
