AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT H207152 WITH BLUE LAKE CIVIL FOR DESIGN OF THE AC WATER AND SEWER GROUP JOB 1033 PROJECT AND RELATED ACTIONS.

## **RECITALS**

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. In March 2020, the City of San Diego (City) prepared and advertised a Request for Proposal for selection of a consultant to design the AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 project (Project). Through the competitive selection process, Blue Lake Civil was identified as the most qualified consultant. On August 3, 2021, Council adopted Ordinance O-21363 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to execute a consultant agreement with Blue Lake Civil to provide professional design and engineering services for the Project (Agreement).

B. On September 19, 2023, Council adopted Ordinance O-21717, authorizing a first amendment to the Agreement (First Amendment), extending the term through July 24, 2028, and increasing the not-to-exceed amount of the Agreement by \$975,270 to cover additional design requirements.

C. Due to the size and complexity of the Project, the City determined that the Project should be split into three separate phases. The City has also determined that additional investigations and pipe replacements are necessary to fulfill the original intent of the Project.

D. The above changes to the scope now require a second amendment to the Agreement to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$2,354,733 and extend the term through July 24, 2030 (Second Amendment).

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

F. The Second Amendment is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

## ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The Council approves the Second Amendment.

Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the Second Amendment for the professional design and engineering services in CIP A-KB.00003, Main Replacements (CIP B-18021, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 (W), CIP B-25015 AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 West (W), and CIP B-25014, AC Water and Sewer Group 1033 North (W)); and in CIP A-JA.00001, Sewer Main Replacements (CIP B-18022, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 (S) and B-25016 AC Water and Sewer Group 1033 West (S)), in an amount not to exceed \$2,354,733. When signed by both parties, the Second Amendment will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend funds under the Second Amendment in an amount not to exceed \$2,354,733, of which \$482,594.32 is in CIP A-KB.00003, Main Replacements (B-18021, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 (W)); \$454,204.00 is in CIP A-KB.00003, Main Replacements (B-25014, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 North (W)), \$680,724.10 is in CIP A-KB.00003, Main Replacements (B-25015, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 West (W)), Fund 700010, Water Utility CIP; \$445,471.68 is in CIP A-JA.00001, Sewer Main Replacements (B-18022, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 (S)); and \$291,738.90 is in CIP A-JA.00001, Sewer Main Replacements (B-25016, AC Water and Sewer Group Job 1033 West (S)), Fund 700008, Muni Sewer CIP, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure under the established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 5. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
