

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- **21941** (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE **APR 24 2025**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE END-OF-LIFE COMPUTER HARDWARE DONATION PROGRAM WITH THE SAN DIEGO FUTURES FOUNDATION, EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 22.0506 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, TO REFURBISH AND DISTRIBUTE COMPUTER HARDWARE TO SAN DIEGANS IN NEED.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

- A. The City of San Diego (City) regularly replaces its computers when the equipment is at the end of its useful life for service for the City or otherwise does not adequately satisfy the City's requirements.
- B. There are underserved communities in the City that would benefit from being able to use computer equipment that the City determines it needs to replace.
- C. The mission of the San Diego Futures Foundation (SDFF) focuses on improving lives in San Diego by making information technology available to underserved populations by providing technology equipment to nonprofit organizations, low income individuals, and other eligible participants.
- D. The Department of Information Technology is requesting to extend the City's program with SDFF to repurpose computers and other hardware that has reached the end of its useful life for City employees but can be refurbished to provide quality technology to households in need; the End-of-Life Computer Donation Program will continue to be exempt from Section 22.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code regarding Obsolete or Depreciated Property.

E. In August 2020, the San Diego City Council, via O-21228, authorized the City's Chief Information Officer to implement an End-of-Life Computer Donation Program, and a no-cost, nonprofit agreement with the SDFF was executed to operationalize the program shortly thereafter.

F. Since 2020, the SDFF has partnered with the City to refurbish or recycle end-of-life computer equipment on the City's behalf.

G. The refurbished computers, monitors, keyboards and more provide members of a household with opportunities to search and apply for work, conduct work, and school activities remotely, access e-government services such as the City's Get It Done application, communicate with friends and family, and have easier access to health and safety information providers.

H. If this ordinance is approved and the end-of life computer hardware donation program is extended, the City will be able to continue to provide SDFF with computer hardware to refurbish and then provide at a low cost to San Diegans who meet standard criteria, including being a San Diego County resident and providing proof of low income or government assistance; some of the individuals who receive computers include students, veterans, seniors, or those who have documented disabilities.

I. Under San Diego City Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approved by a two-thirds' majority vote of the Council.

J. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS


Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The Mayor or his designee is authorized to continue a program administered by the City's Chief Information Officer or his designee that donates used computer equipment to the San Diego Futures Foundation (SDFF) for SDFF to make available to nonprofit organizations, low income individuals, and other eligible participants, that the program will have its term extended by up to five (5) years, and that the program will be exempt from the provisions of Section 22.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code regarding the disposal of Obsolete or Depreciated property.

Section 2. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 3. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
