DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 2 2 2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE OBLIGATIONS OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT K-20-1907-DBB-3 FOR THE REMAINING SMALL DIAMETER CI WATER PHASE 2 PROJECT TO EXTEND BEYOND FIVE YEARS TO DECEMBER 4, 2026.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

- A. On June 4, 2020, the City of San Diego (City) entered into construction contract K-20-1907-DBB-3 (Contract) for the Remaining Small Diameter CI Water Phase 2 project (Project) with Ortiz Corporation (Ortiz) for \$5,457,505.56.
- B. The Contract will hit the five-year mark on June 4, 2025, and is currently in the punchlist and close-out phase. The obligations of the Contract need to be extended beyond five years to address the remaining punchlist work and Contract close-out tasks.
- C. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.
- D. Extension of the Contract is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The obligations of construction contract K-20-1907-DBB-3 for the Remaining Small Diameter CI Water Phase 2 project with Ortiz Corporation are authorized to

extend beyond five years for an additional 18 months to December 4, 2026, to allow Ortiz to complete punchlist work and close-out tasks.

Section 2. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.
