AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
THE AS-NEEDED LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL
SERVICES CONSULTANT AGREEMENT [H197100] WITH
KTU&A.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. The City of San Diego (City) utilizes as-needed landscape architectural services in support of the execution of its Capital Improvements Program (CIP) and for other public projects Citywide.

B. By Resolution R-312880 (March 13, 2020), the Council approved a five-year As-Needed Landscape Architectural Services Consultant Agreement [H197100] (Agreement) with KTU&A to help meet increased CIP demands. The City and KTU&A signed the Agreement dated May 6, 2020, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. R-312880-3.

C. The City and KTU&A now desire to execute a time-extension only First Amendment to the Agreement (First Amendment), with no expenditure of City funds beyond the authorized amount of the Agreement, to complete the task orders issued during the first sixty (60) months of the Agreement. To meet this objective, the City and KTU&A negotiated the terms of the proposed First Amendment, included in the docket materials accompanying this Ordinance. The First Amendment will extend the term of the Agreement from sixty (60) months to ninety-six (96) months, to complete the task orders attached to the First Amendment as Exhibit H (Ongoing Task Orders), in accordance with the Scope of Services.

D. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

E. The Agreement is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The Council approves the First Amendment.


Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the First Amendment. When signed by both parties, the First Amendment will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21953.

Section 3. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
