A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A RELINQUISHMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE CITY TO ACCEPT TITLE TO A NONMOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION FACILITY AND ASSOCIATED APPROXIMATELY 2.5 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY ALONG INTERSTATE 5, BOUNDED BY BOSTON AVENUE, 29TH STREET, AND 32ND STREET.

## RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) recently constructed a nonmotorized multi-use pathway on approximately 2.5 acres of real property along Interstate 5, bounded by Boston Avenue, 29th Street, and 32nd Street (Property) owned by Caltrans.
- B. Under California Streets and Highways Code section 73, Caltrans may relinquish to the City any nonmotorized transportation facility constructed as part of a state highway project within the territorial limits of the City if the Council approves an agreement authorizing the relinquishment.
- C. City staff and Caltrans staff negotiated the proposed relinquishment agreement (Relinquishment Agreement) included in the docket materials accompanying this Resolution.

  Under the proposed Relinquishment Agreement, Caltrans will relinquish the Property to the City at no direct cost to the City, but the City will assume the general costs of ownership of the Property.
- D. The Property value determined by the City's Principal Appraiser is \$125,000 based on market data.

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- 1. The Council approves the Relinquishment Agreement.
- 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on behalf of the City, to sign and deliver the Relinquishment Agreement and all other documents necessary or appropriate to perform the City's obligations under the Relinquishment Agreement. When signed by both parties, the Relinquishment Agreement will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document 316047
