A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF AN AGREEMENT WITH ALLIED WASTE SYSTEMS, INC., DBA REPUBLIC SERVICES OF SAN DIEGO, FOR TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES AT CITY FACILITIES IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301, 15308, AND 15323.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. The Council will consider approval of an agreement with Allied Waste Systems, Inc. dba Republic Services for Trash and Recycling Collection Services Allied at City Facilities (Project).
- B. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), California Public Resources Code (Code) sections 21000-21189.3, provides in Code section 21083 that the California Office of Planning and Research will promulgate, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency will adopt, guidelines for implementation of CEQA. The California Office of Planning and Research promulgated, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency adopted, the guidelines for implementation of CEQA set forth in Title 14 California Code of Regulations sections 15000 through 15387 (CEQA Guidelines).
- C. Code section 21084 requires the CEQA Guidelines to include a list of classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and are exempt from the provisions of CEQA. CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 through 15333 list classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and declared to be exempt from preparation of environmental documents under CEQA.

- D. The Council has considered the written record related to the Project and all public comments about the potential environmental effects of the Project. The Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (titled "Existing Facilities"), 15308 (titled "Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment"), and 15323 (titled "Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings") on the basis that the Project relates to the normal operation of existing public facilities and will assure the maintenance and protection of the environment.
- E. No exception to the application of a categorical exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project.
- F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- The Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA
 Guidelines sections 15301, 15308, and 15323.
- 2. No exception to the application of a categorical exemption set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project.
