A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS AND  
REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE MOBILITY BOARD.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. Modes of transportation in the City of San Diego (City) have evolved dramatically in the past decade, with critical issues emerging within the City's transportation network and a need to better coordinate different transportation decisions.
- B. Under San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.38 and 26.39, the City created the Mobility Board to advise the Mayor and the Council of the City on the City's transportation network.
- C. The Mobility Board holistically analyzes transportation decision-making to help the City ensure that people driving, walking, bicycling, taking transit, parking, or using other transportation modes will have safe, easy-to-use choices to move around the City.
- D. The Mobility Board helps ensure the development of the City's transportation network meets the City's Climate Action Plan goals.
- E. The Mobility Board is composed of 13 appointed volunteer members serving two-year staggered terms. The terms of no more than seven members shall expire in the same year, and members will serve until a new member is duly appointed and confirmed.

F. Members of the Mobility Board shall possess expertise in one or more of the following areas: transportation and transit planning, bicycle and pedestrian safety, city planning, parking management, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), construction management, environmental sustainability, and public health. One of the 13 members must have expertise in or demonstrated knowledge of the ADA and accommodation issues.

G. The Mayor now seeks to appoint members of the Mobility Board, subject to Council confirmation.

H. The Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate.


